FFI members have a spirit of adventure! They are flexible and adapt to uncertain circumstances with energy and enthusiasm.

Positive

FFI members always consider the needs of others and seek to give more to host communities than they take. FFI members seek to be a force for good and aim to have a positive impact wherever they go.

Innovative

FFI seeks to be constantly evolving; adapting to new and better ways of carrying out our goals. FFI will be responsive to cultural and social changes. FFI members are open to change.

● You must act in an appropriate manner and respect local law and customs wherever you are travelling. Ask for consent when taking photographs of local people. The Friendship Force member/ambassador hereby agrees to accept that the activity is a public event and that the **photograph** and name of the Ambassador may be used by the local and national media and Friendship Force International and local Friendship Force chapters in their publications. To comply with the European Union (**EU**) **general data protection** regulation (GDPR), the chapter documents that include personal information, will not be shared outside FFI and local chapters without permission from that individual.

● The Friendship Force Member understands that the scope of their relationship with Friendship Force International (and all chapters) is limited to a **volunteer** position and that no compensation or employment-related benefits are expected in return for services provided by the Friendship Force Member. The Friendship Force Member recognizes that connected with any travel there are risks of loss, damage, and injury to persons and property, and the Member is willing to assume and bear those risks. The Member also recognizes that they are responsible for complying with all laws of all countries visited. Therefore, the Friendship Force Member agrees to and does hereby release, indemnify, and **hold harmless** Friendship Force International and local chapters (which shall include the directors, officers, and employees thereof, as well as its volunteer leaders and members) from all claims, actions, and causes of action related to Friendship Force events, journeys or other activities. The Friendship Force Member understands and acknowledges that this **release** discharges Friendship Force International (and local chapters) from any **liability** or claim that they may have against Friendship Force International with respect to bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from the Member's involvement in Friendship Force activities.
